VAMPIRE - BLOOD AND PROTEIN REMOVER

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

VAMPIRE is a spotting agent used for blood stains and protein deposits. Ideal as a wet spotter for all types of protein stains. VAMPIRE may be used as a presoak, too.

PROPERTIES:

Form:	Liquid
Color:	Colorless, clear
Odor:	Ammonia

USE DIRECTIONS:

For prespotting, moisten stained area with water. Apply VAMPIRE with a bone scraper or brush. Flush with water or place directly into washer.

For cleaning large areas of blood stains, mix 1 quart of VAMPIRE with 1 gallon of water. Immerse stained linen in solution. Flush with water or place directly into washer.

CAUTION:

May cause irritation to eyes and mucous membranes. Do not breath vapors. For contact with eyes, flush thoroughly with water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention. If mucous membrane irritation continues, see a physician. Do not ingest. Consult the Material Safety Data Sheet for additional precautions.
